SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This application is open to any high school senior, college or technical school freshman who is a resident of Wakefield, (Union, Sanbornville, and East Wakefield) or Brookfield, NH or the child of a Lovell Lake Association member.

The following criteria apply:

1. The student must have maintained a B average for the last two quarters of their junior year, and the first two quarters of their senior year. If the applicant is a college freshman transcripts of their first two college quarters will be sufficient.
2. Students who have a C average may be considered with a recommendation from their principal or appropriate college faculty member.
3. As the Lovell Lake Association has a major concern for the environment, it is our desire to be able to offer this scholarship to a student entering into a field of study related to the environment, such as marine biology, forestry, surveying, environmental engineering, etc. in a two or four year institution, including a technical college. However, those going into other fields are also encouraged to apply.
4. There will be a minimum of one \$750.00 scholarship to be awarded. The check will be awarded at the end of the first semester, provided a C average has been maintained for the first semester of the college year. The award will be made out to the recipient and the school attending so that it can be applied to the second semester tuition in the first or second year, whichever applies.
